For this reason, I am proud to offer my support for Lansdowne's request for Stage 1 planning approval, and respectfully ask that you prioritize Lansdowne through your Ministry's results-based planning process later this year.

Thank you again for your time and commitment to the children and youth of our community. Together, we will make Lansdowne's vision a reality.
